Anticipating Challenges	The student lists multiple potential challenges, demonstrating deep thought about the complexities and pitfalls of app design and development.	The student lists a few potential challenges but may miss out on some critical aspects.	The student identifies only very obvious challenges or has difficulty listing potential issues.
Prioritizing Potential Failures	The student effectively ranks potential failures based on both likelihood and impact, demonstrating an understanding of which issues would be most critical to the project.	The student ranks some issues but may not prioritize them effectively based on both likelihood and impact.	The student does not rank potential failures or ranks them without clear reasoning.
Developing Mitigation Strategies	The student has difficulty proposing mitigation strategies or provides solutions that are not practical or relevant.	The student proposes some mitigation strategies, but they might be generic or not fully tailored to the specific challenges.	The student proposes thoughtful and practical mitigation strategies for the top potential failures, demonstrating creativity and proactive problem-solving.
Communication and Collaboration	The student rarely participates or has difficulty communicating their ideas during discussions.	The student participates in discussions but might occasionally overshadow others or not contribute substantially.	The student actively listens to peers, builds on others' ideas, and communicates their thoughts clearly and effectively during group discussions.
